Air Curtain Installation – Islamorada Canal #137 Treasure Harbor, Plantation Key

- A. Project completed in November 2014 with design, permitting & construction costs \$64,000
- B. Islamorada funding the O&M with annual cost \$3,500
- C. HOA residents paying electric approximately \$300 monthly
 - 1. Operation of 3 compressors
- D. Lessons learned
 - Additional air needed at canal entrance due to long distance from compressors





Air Curtain Installation – Islamorada Canal #145 Lower Matecumbe Key

- A. Public Private partnership
 - Local property owner
- B. Islamorada approved \$47,000
 June 2016 for design and
 permitting private homeowner to
 provide funding for construction
 and installation
- Permit applications submitted to federal, state, and local agencies





Air Curtain Installation – Islamorada Canal #148 Lower Matecumbe Key

- A. Canal included in initial 2013 EPA monitoring grant for restoration projects
 - 1. Have base line data for the site
- B. DEP to provide \$50,000 for construction costs approved 2016
- Islamorada will provide matching funds for design and permitting
- Permit applications submitted to federal, state, and local agencies
