CLEAN MARINA AND CLEAN BOATYARD

Clean Marina and Clean Boatyard designations are given by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection to marinas and boatyards that meet federal and state environmental regulations as well as provide environmental education and services to boaters. SAFETY AND SECURITY ZONES

The U.S. Coast Guard has established security and safety zones around commercial vessels and facilities in Tampa Bay. This includes all tank vessels that transport hazardous cargo; passenger vessels and terminals; Naval vessels, Coast Guard vessels and bases, the Sunshine Skyway Bridge, MacDill Air Force Base, and power plants. Failure to comply with these zones could lead to a \$250,000 fine, six years in prison, and the loss of your boat. The Manatee Key Zone Watch program was established as a mechanism for boaters to be granted access to the waters around Manatee Key while maintaining the desired level of security. For more information about the Manatee Key Zone Watch program, visit www.portmanatee.com and search for "Zone Watch."

DIVER DOWN FLAG

It is REQUIRED BY LAW to display this flag when divers are in the water. Boaters in the vicinity of a vessel displaying the diver down flag must give 100' clearance inshore or 300' clearance in open waters. A flag displayed on a vessel must be 20" by 24" or larger. A stiffener is also required to keep the flag unfurled.
