Hi Teresa.

Thanks for the reminder to comment. I have no substantive comments on the overall restoration at Crane Point Hammock, however I have a few technical comments on the UMAM scores. At our annual meeting, we discussed the need to make sure UMAMs prepared for impact sites use the same scoring convention as UMAMs prepared for mitigation sites. Since this time, my office has been collecting UMAMs from the USACE Miami Regulatory Office for projects that plan to use the ILF for their mitigation. I reviewed the UMAMs in the CRG ERP application and it appears the scoring convention is similar to how impact UMAMs are being developed.

However, additional information is needed for the UMAMs provided:

1) UMAM Sheet Is are not provided in the ERP (only UMAM Sheet II and summary tables are provided)

2) The mangrove impacts that would occur during project construction at Crane Point Hammock (0.22 ac total; 0.16 ac alteration + 0.06 removal) did not result in a functional loss (FL). While it may be possible the alteration (e.g., trimming) would not result in a FL, I do not see the justification for mangrove removal not resulting in a FL - this justification is typically what you would see in a UMAM Sheet I. Alternatively, there could be a type-o. Appendix E, Page 92 of 102 provides the UMAM Sheet II with a delta of -0.03 that did not translate into a FL and this error is then repeated in the summary table Appendix C, Page 98 of 102
